**Transfer Site—outside the gate  
24/7**

**Paper—any kind.**

**Aluminum—cans, cooking pans, foil.**



**Cardboard—flattened.**



**Yard Waste—lawn clippings, leaves, small twigs, and flowers may be dumped at the Compost Site adjacent to the Transfer Site.  
(Please NO large limbs or burnable items.)**

### Inside Building

**Steel & Tin Cans—soup cans, veggie cans, coffee cans, etc.**

**Plastics—#1 and #2. Look for symbols**



**Office Paper—sheets or shredded.**

**Cardboard—flattened or not**

**Tires—accepted for a fee based on size.**

**Car/Truck Batteries—a fee of \$1.00 will be charged at the transfer site. Residents are encouraged to use the core option at the local auto parts store for rebate.**

### Outside Building

**Mixed metal—nails, screws, metal hardware, & implements**

**Appliances—for a fee. Freon must be removed by local appliance repair company and certificate provided.**

**Trees & Limbs—place in burn pile.  
Please NO paint, stain, glue, or manufactured wood to insure air quality.**
